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### CONDITONS OF ENTRY

1. All sections will be judged as a Total Look. Your model must be able to parade on stage as well as stand/sit for judging.
2. Judges would like to see the latest in hair & fashion. Your inspiration should come from runway fashion and high fashion magazines, latest movie and music video fashion.
3. All models will be paraded before judging. Models in Competitions 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 14, and 15 will be judged during catwalk parade, as well as sitting/standing in judging area.
4. All models will be standing for the judges in the judging area, and sit when asked by the chairperson of the section being judged.
5. All models must be able to parade, then sit/stand without assistance and should not hinder any other person on the judging floor or catwalk.
6. In all Pre-Done Sections multiple entries will be allowed.
7. In all Pre-Done Sections it is understood that all work presented was carried out by the competitor named on the entry form. Entry may be disqualified or award forfeited if not.
8. I.H.S. reserves the right to remove any competitor from the stage/floor who indulges in unsafe workplace or safety practices.
9. No late arrival models will be included once judging has commenced.
10. First, second and third place will be awarded in all sections to; Competitor, as well as Model, Stylist/Designer and Make-Up Artist.
11. In the junior sections, awards of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placing will be awarded to the Competitor, Model, Stylist/Designer, Make-Up Artist as well as their employer.
12. PLEASE NOTE: If you intend to use your model in more than one competition, or you yourself are a model in another competition, please allow sufficient time for judging, as competitions will not be delayed if you or your model is not in attendance for parade and judging, at the time allocated to this section.
13. Models must not touch their own hair whilst on the competition or judging floor.
14. The International Hairstylists Society shall not be responsible or liable for models or for any damage arising out of work performed on model's hair.
15. No mobile phones will be allowed on the competition floor.
16. Any person disturbing competitors on the floor will be removed from the venue.
17. On completion of judging, all competitors must allow their models to be photographed by the official I.H.S. photographer and chairperson of judging.
18. Any competitor who causes damage to the competition venue, hotel rooms or towels, will be liable for costs.
19. Exclusive copyright in any competition work is the property of the individual hairstylist. Each hairstylist hereby agrees to assign this copyright to the competition promoter.
20. Any reproduction, including photographic or video recorded, will infringe copyright. The sale of any reproduction without the promoter's permission is prohibited.
21. The promoter hereby grants permission to person's only using reproductions for private or educational purposes PROVIDED the reproduction is not sold in any way.
22. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any person(s).
23. You must state the fact your award was awarded in an I.H.S. competition, with the year and category of the award stated if you market by any media or advertising the winner of any Salon, College, Senior or Junior Award.
24. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

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## GENERAL RULES FOR THE FOLLOWING PRE-DONE COMPETITIONS

### 1. JUNIOR MEN'S CUTTING – TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all trainees, apprentices and students who have not completed 2000 hours in training.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Male models must be used.
- b. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- c. Colour must be used to compliment the haircut.
- d. No wigs, hairpieces, or extensions allowed.
- e. Your model must be finished in a total look form.
- f. Models will be paraded on the catwalk prior to judging the haircut. This is a total look – dress of model will be considered in final judging, but main emphasis will be on the haircut.

NOTE: It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Men's sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

IT IS A CONDITION FOR THIS ENTRY THAT ALL WORK IS TO BE CARRIED OUT BY THE APPRENTICE/STUDENT.

### 2. JUNIOR LADIES CUTTING – TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all trainees, apprentices and students who have not completed 2000 hours in training.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female models must be used.
- b. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor)
- c. Colour must be used to compliment the haircut.
- d. No wigs, hairpieces, or extensions allowed.
- e. Your model must be finished in a total look form.
- f. Models will be paraded on the catwalk prior to judging the haircut. This is a total look – dress and make-up of the model will be considered in final judging, but main emphasis will be on the haircut.

NOTE: It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

IT IS A CONDITION FOR THIS ENTRY THAT ALL WORK IS TO BE CARRIED OUT BY THE APPRENTICE/STUDENT.

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### 3. OPEN MEN'S CUTTING - TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Male model must be used.
- b. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- c. Colour must be used to compliment the haircut.
- d. No wigs, hairpieces, or extensions allowed.
- e. Your model must be finished in a total look form.
- f. Models will be paraded on the catwalk prior to judging the haircut. This is a total look – dress of the model will be considered in final judging, but the main emphasis will be on the haircut.

NOTE: It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Men's sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

### 4. OPEN LADIES CUTTING – TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female model must be used.
- b. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- c. Colour must be used to compliment the haircut.
- d. No wigs, hairpieces, or extensions allowed.
- e. Your model must be finished in a total look form.
- f. Models will be paraded on the catwalk prior to judging the haircut. This is a total look – dress and make-up of the model will be considered in final judging, but the main emphasis will be on the haircut.

NOTE: It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

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## 5. JUNIOR LADIES CATWALK - TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all trainees, apprentices and students who have not completed 2000 hours in training.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female model must be used.
- b. Colour must be used to compliment the hairstyle.
- c. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- d. Your model must be finished in a total look form. Dress and make-up will be considered in final judging. Your finished look must resemble the standard you would see on the catwalk fashion parade in London, Paris and New York.
- e. Your model will parade on the catwalk, to a 60 second music CD of your choice (submitted by you to the registration desk prior to the competition) to present your Total Look to Judges and audience.

NOTE: Models will be judged while parading on the catwalk as well as sitting/standing for final Judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

IT IS A CONDITION FOR THIS ENTRY THAT ALL WORK IS TO BE CARRIED OUT BY THE APPRENTICE/STUDENT.

## 6. OPEN MEN'S HIGH FASHION COLOUR – TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Male model must be used.
- b. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- c. Your model must be finished in a total look form. Dress of the model will be considered.
- d. **NO** wigs, hairpieces, extensions or coloured styling products to be used.
- e. Colour to compliment a high fashion hairstyle.

NOTE: This competition is the top end of the colour fashion market. Combine colour with new hairstyle trends.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Men's sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

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## 7. OPEN LADIES CATWALK - TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female models must be used.
- b. Colour must be used to compliment the hairstyle.
- c. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor)
- d. Your model must be finished in a total look form. Dress and make-up will be considered in final judging. Your finished look must resemble the standard you would see on the catwalk fashion parade in London, Paris and New York.
- e. Your model will parade on the catwalk, to a 60 second music CD of your choice (submitted by you to the registration desk prior to the competition) to present your Total Look to Judges and audience.

NOTE: Models will be judged while parading on the catwalk as well as sitting/standing for final judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

## 8. JUNIOR WAY OUT COLOUR- TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all trainees, apprentices and students who have not completed 2000 hours in training.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. A female model must be used.
- b. Judges are asking the competitor to express their creativity and imagination and give us their **WAY-OUT AVANT GARDE** Colour Creation.
- c. Strong and vibrant colours must be used to compliment the hairstyle. Colour must compliment a way out hairstyle.
- d. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (no work to be done on the competition floor).
- e. **NO** wigs, hairpieces, extensions or colour styling products to be used.

NOTE: Models will parade on the catwalk prior to judging, and be standing/sitting for final judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

IT IS A CONDITION FOR THIS ENTRY THAT ALL WORK IS TO BE CARRIED OUT BY THE APPRENTICE/STUDENT.

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## 9. OPEN MEN'S CATWALK - TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Male model must be used.
- b. Colour must be used to compliment the hairstyle.
- c. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- d. Your model must be finished in a total look form. Dress of model will be considered in final judging.
- e. Your model will parade on the catwalk, to a 60 second music CD, submitted by you to the registration desk prior to the competition, to present your Total Look to Judges and audience.

NOTE: Models will be judged while parading on the catwalk as well as sitting/standing for final judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Men's sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

## 10. OPEN LADIES' BLONDE DOMINANT HIGH FASHION COLOUR - TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female model must be used.
- b. Judges are looking for a colour that is Blonde Dominant with shading variables.
- c. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- d. Your model must be finished in a total look form. Dress and make-up will be considered in final judging.
- e. Colour to complement high fashion hairstyle.
- f. **NO** wigs, hairpieces, extensions or coloured styling products to be used.

NOTE: This competition is the top end of the colour fashion market.

Your model will parade on stage to present your look to the audience as well as sitting/standing for the final judging

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

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## 11. OPEN BRIDAL - TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

THIS COMPETITION IS TO EXPRESS YOUR VISION OF A 2013 BRIDAL LOOK

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female model must be used.
- b. Models to be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- c. This is a total look competition, bridal dress and make-up will be considered in final judging.
- d. All models will be judged Head to Toe, in a 2 part judging.
- e. Hairpieces may be used, but must not cover more than one third of the finished hairstyle. (Full wigs are not allowed).
- f. Models will be paraded on the catwalk for the judges, to a 60 second music provided by I.H.S, as well as standing/sitting, for final judging.
- g. Credit of gown designers will be announced during the parade (names to be supplied during registration).

NOTE: Veils may be used, however, emphasis will be placed on visible hair work.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

## 12. OPEN LADIES' HIGH FASHION COLOUR – TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition

Open to all hairdressers.

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female model must be used.
- b. Models must be finished and ready for judging. (No work to be done on the competition floor).
- c. Your model must be finished in a total look form. Dress and make-up will be considered.
- d. Colour to compliment a high fashion hairstyle.
- e. **NO** wigs, hairpieces, extensions or coloured styling products to be used.

NOTE: This competition is the top end of the fashion market. Combine colour with new hairstyle trends.

Your model will parade on stage to present your look to the audience as well as sitting/standing for the judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

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### 13. OPEN SALON TEAM FREE EXPRESSION ALL IN ON STAGE – TOTAL LOOK

Open to all hairdressers.

Judges will be looking for imagination and creativity in a Free Expressive Total Look Avant Garde Hairstyle and make-up Total Look. (Can be entered under a salon name).

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. A female model must be used.
- b. Total time allowed 9 minutes.
- c. Up to three (3) stylists can work on a model at any one time.
- d. Anything may be used to create your look but your model must be able to stand and parade or dance to present to the Judges, in a safe manner.
- e. Models hair must be in first Pli, ie: Set in rollers, crimped, tonged etc, but not brushed out or in a complete finished form.
- f. Hairpieces and pre-done extensions may be used.
- g. **NO** full wigs allowed.
- h. You must name your hairstyle creation.
- i. No support props.
- j. No Mirror or Power supplied, only a chair on stage will be provided.
- k. Your model will parade on the catwalk, to a 60 second music CD of your choice (to be submitted by you to the registration desk prior to the competition) to present your Total Look to Judges and audience.

NOTE: Models will be judged while parading on the catwalk as well as sitting/standing for final judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.

(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

### 14. OPEN HIGH FASHION COLLECTION – TOTAL LOOK

This is a Pre-Done competition.

Open to all hairdressers.

Three (3) female models to be presented for this competition.

This competition should project your high fashion work in a total look image for the audience, camera and magazines. (Can be entered under a salon name)

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. All 3 models to be finished and ready for judging (no work to be done on the competition floor)
- b. Your collection must be named and all three models should transform the image to the name of your collection.
- c. Hair, clothes, make-up and accessories will be judged for the total fashion look of your entire collection. Credits of gown designers will be announced during the parade, (names to be supplied at registration).
- d. Colour must be used on all models of your collection to compliment the hairstyles.



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- e. No support props allowed.
  - f. Your models must be finished in a total look form.
  - g. **NO** full wigs allowed.
  - h. Your models will parade on the catwalk, to a 60 second music CD (submitted by you to the registration desk prior to the competition) to present your collection to Judges and audience.

NOTE: Models will be judged while parading on the catwalk as well as sitting/standing for final judging.

Maximum presentation time 60 seconds.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.  
(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).

### **15. OPEN SALON TEAM COUTURE CATWALK ALL IN ON STAGE - TOTAL LOOK**

Open to all Hairdressers.

Judges will be looking for imagination and creativity in a Couture Catwalk Hairstyle in a Total Image, to reflect a high fashion look that you would see in Paris, London or New York (Can be entered under a salon name).

Competitors must read and abide by the conditions of entry.

- a. Female model must be used.
- b. Total time allowed 9 minutes.
- c. Up to three (3) stylists can work on a female model at any one time.
- d. Anything may be used (including pre-done hair pieces) to create your Total Look but your model must be able to stand and parade to present your creation to the Judges, in a safe manner.
- e. You must name your hairstyle Catwalk creation.
- f. No support props
- g. Models hair must be in first Pli, ie: Set in rollers, crimped, tonged etc, but not brushed out or in a complete finished form.
- h. Hairpieces and extensions may be pre-done.
- i. **NO** full wigs allowed.
- j. No mirror or power supplied, only a chair on stage will be provided.
- k. Your model will parade on the catwalk, to a 60 second music CD of your choice (to be submitted by you to the registration desk prior to the competition) to present your Total Look to Judges and audience.

NOTE: Models will be judged while parading on the catwalk as well as sitting/standing for final judging.

It is preferred that your model remains in attendance until all winners are announced.

Multiple entries are allowed, and each additional entry will require an additional entry fee.

This model is also eligible to re-enter other Ladies sections provided judging times do not clash.  
(You must re-enter the sections to qualify, and additional entry fees will be required).
